

Boggs Sets Record in Lady Arrow Win

Sophomore Jessica Boggs set a new single game record in the Tecumseh Lady Arrow Soccer Team's 10-0 win over the Indian Lake Lady Lakers. It has been a whirlwind week for Boggs as she has scored 13 goals and has 3 assists in four games so far this season.

The scoring began early and often for Tecumseh as Boggs fed Nicole Snyder with a nice pass from the right side at 37:57 for a 1-0 lead. Boggs then took advantage of the support of many of her teammates who supplied her with some great passes which she turned into five straight goals. She scored off a pass from Snyder at 24:12 for a 2-0 margin. Allison Denton then made a nice thru pass for her next score at 11:04. Anna Studebaker then found Boggs with two great passes from the left side for scores at 5:53 and 1:51 to finish the first half with a 5-0 lead.

In the half several Arrow players took shots to the tune of 27-0 in scoring attempts. Tecumseh also dominated possession by have 72 intercepts and won 13 of 19 50/50 balls. Coach Jim Paxton was thrilled with the scoring but stressed to his team the importance of making good passes and using the whole width of the field in their attack. He encouraged the outside midfielders to keep up with the offense as it got into scoring position and make their runs in order to create more space and give better support to the forwards.

The second half began much like the first as Boggs scored her fifth goal in succession at 36:51 as she put back into the net a deflection off a shot by Casey Cope, 6-0. Allison Denton got into the act at 35:43 off a pass from Boggs who then went on to set the record at 26:45 for an 8-0 lead. Boggs took a rest and then played on defense the rest of the night. The scoring did not stop however as Cope put one in goal at 24:46 off a pass from Denton, 9-0. Michele Milligan finished the scoring at 21:30 as she broke thru on a nice pass from Snyder for the 10-0 final.

Kellie Gruber had four saves for the Arrows and her third shutout in a row as they improve to 3 -1 on the season. Tecumseh plays next at Miami East on Saturday in a 2:30 pm start.
