The ec meh Lady Aw Sc c er eam foght had for 90 minutes and came away with a 2-2 tie against the Shins Ladyhdians on Friday. The game was a very fast paced affair and the Awv played one of their best halves of the season in the first part of the contest. Felman Jesca Boggs scored first on a nice pass from Anne Alen at 25 for the first goal of the game and a 1-0 lead. Tom Miblo followed that with another goal at 32 of a pass from Misa Sine for a 2-0 margin. That would be out to be all of the scoring for ec meh although they shot the hdians 10-8 in the first half. They also were very accurate winning 15 of 20/20 balls and intercepted the ball 3 times.

Coach Jim Brown complimented the team on their passing and urged them to be prepared for a game by Shins to begin the second half. He also implored them to put pressure on the defense and to keep the ball in front and to be aware of the side attack that was happening from behind.

Well, just like the tide on the ocean the hdians came flooding in and the Awv were having problems controlling the midfield throughout the second half. Billy Alon scored first for Shins at 32 to cut the lead to 2-1 and changed the complexion of the game from that point on. Both sides played with a greater sense of urgency that saw the hdians gain the upper hand in possession and scoring attempts. Cobey Sinitat made an excellent diving save at 41:20 to prevent Alon from scoring the tying goal from the middle of the field on a break through attempt. With the game winding down and only 38 left the hdians were able to penetrate the Awv defense from the left side on a shot by Ashley Ferguson that tied the game at 2-2 for the final margin.

Credit the Awv with a good effort against a quality team and the great defense by Aly Triplett, Kelly Kajala and Sara Enny. Cobey Sinitat had a nice game in the goal with 10 saves. The Awv look to get back to their winning ways on their final home game and Senior Night on Wednesday.
